- The call for submissions is now open. Students can find the submission form and guidelines at the URCW website (<http://urcw.highpoint.edu/HIGH-PURCS/>). Submission deadline is March 16. Students will be notified of the acceptance of their project by April 2.
- Submission includes two abstracts/descriptions: a short 50-word (max) abstract that will be published in our program; and a longer 250-word (max) description for the review.
- Projects must be approved by a faculty mentor. Students are instructed to complete the form and send it to their faculty mentor (not to submit it). Mentors will submit the form.
